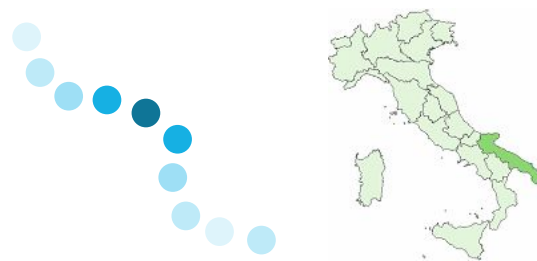

LITERARY CONNECTIONS... «PUGLIA SITICULOSA»



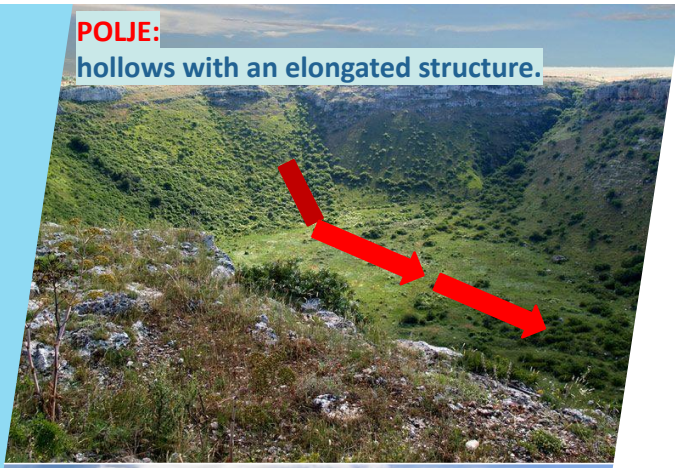
HORACE FLACCUS AND HIS
«**PUGLIA SITICULOSA**» =>
PARCHED LAND OF APULIA



The Latin poet Horace Flaccus in his work "*The Satires*", attributed to this area the adjective "**siticulosa**" that means "**thirsty**" or "**parched**", having this land almost no rainfall during the Spring and during the Summer.

POLJE:

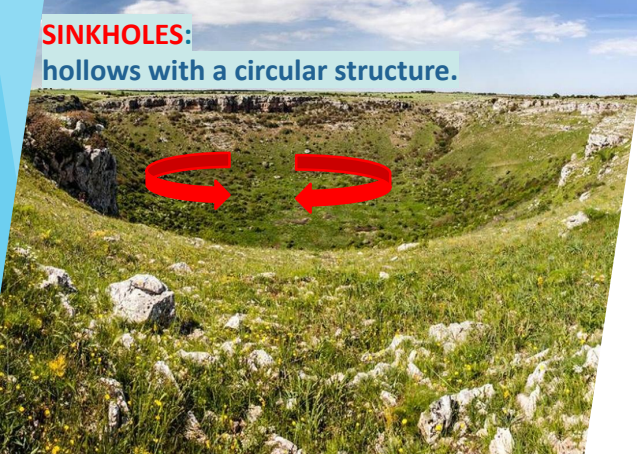
hollows with an elongated structure.

hollows with a circular structure.
